# What is a “TANA”?

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**T**echnical  
**A**ssistance  
**N**eeds  
**A**ssessment

- A process to identify whether a community requires additional support:
  - Understanding technical information
  - Meaningful participation in the Superfund decision-making process

# What makes up a Technical Assistance Needs Assessment?

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- Integration of:

- Community-identified technical assistance needs
- Other stakeholder identified technical assistance needs
- Knowledge of how technical assistance needs can be met

 Result:

- Prioritized list of technical needs and recommendations for ways to meet needs

# After Technical Assistance Needs Assessment (TANA)...

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- Distribute the TANA
- Community members make specific technical assistance requests to EPA
- EPA considers requests and meets with the community to discuss options going forward

Technical Assistance Grants (TAG) or  
Technical Assistance Services for Communities  
(TASC) ...Which is the best fit?

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Broad focus

Short or long-term

Any community-based organization eligible

No matching contribution

Services by EPA contractor

Relatively rapid implementation

EPA manages administrative burden

Narrow focus

Long-term

Non-profit incorporated community groups eligible

20% matching required

Services by community Technical Advisor via a contract.

Takes 6-12 months time to get grant going

Community group responsible for administrative tasks

# Technical Assistance Grants (TAG)

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- EPA can award a TAG to qualified community groups for up to \$50,000.
- The community group must be incorporated as a 501(c)3 (non-profit status).
- The primary purpose of the TAG is to hire an independent technical advisor to interpret and comment on site related documents.
- Application process is competitive.



# Technical Assistance Grants (TAG)

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- Applying for a TAG
  - Letter of Intent
  - Eligibility & Application
- Managing a TAG
  - Technical Advisor
  - Allowable & Unallowable activities
  - Providing match
  - Recording keeping & reimbursements
  - Reporting requirements
  - Records retention

# Technical Assistance Services for Communities (TASC)

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- TASC program provides technical help so communities can better understand the science, regulations, and policies of EPA actions.
- Services are provided through a national EPA contract. Under the contract, a contractor provides scientists, engineers and other professionals to review and explain information.

# Technical Assistance Services for Communities (TASC)

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- Technical advisor services
  - Explains technical information
  - Help communities formulate questions and comments on agency documents
- Trainings
- Workshops
- Fact sheets & brochures
- Maps, diagrams, visual aids
- Translations
- Meeting facilitation
- Websites
